- Who will be there?** Regional Advisors, PALC Chairperson, Local and Regional Officers
- Who can attend?** Local Advisors and local and regional officers
- Limit 7 members per Advisor (one school may have multiple advisors)
 - One advisor must be present per every 7 students, if you have males and females you must have a male and female chaperone.
- How to register?** Go to www.skillsusa.org and click "join" to register. For more information on Camp Dixie, including required forms, guidelines, and instructions go to www.nc-ti.org These forms will also be sent electronically to you. They are due by September 10, 2009. A set of instructions will follow this letter.
- Cost?** \$125.00 each (Advisors, Chaperones, and Students)
- What to bring?** Bathing suit (one piece or a two piece with a t-shirt), shorts, tennis shoes, bath essentials (i.e towels and wash cloths, soap, shower shoes, etc.), sheets and pillow. Bring one set of old clothes for the Great Experience that can get muddy. Also bring an umbrella and a flashlight.

- Students are to design a SkillsUSA North Carolina lapel pin and a tee shirt and bring the design to Camp Dixie (Optional). The design will be voted on by the attendees and the winning designs will become our state pin and state t-shirt. Students are also encouraged to submit a pin design for the National Conference Pin Design Contest. One design will be chosen to submit to the national office as our official entry into the contest.
